Faculty Position in Cell and Developmental Biology

The Department of Cell and Developmental Biology invites applications for a tenure-track faculty position. Established investigators with a strong record of productivity and extramural funding are especially encouraged to apply for appointment at the level of Associate or Full Professor. We seek candidates using cutting edge cellular, molecular, biochemical, structural and/or genetic approaches in any area of cell and developmental biology and eukaryotic model systems. Special consideration will be given to those using *C. elegans* or *Drosophila* to investigate fundamental problems in neurobiology such as mechanisms of axon guidance and synapse assembly or function, nuclear organization and dynamics, vesicular trafficking, and tissue differentiation. Successful candidates will receive substantial start-up packages and will be housed in newly constructed/renovated facilities. The appointee will also benefit from a broad array of core facilities, active graduate programs, and an interdisciplinary environment. Vanderbilt University Medical Center is strongly committed to diversity in attracting faculty to fill this position and is an affirmative action, equal opportunity employer. Complete applications should include curriculum vitae, reprints of recent publications, a brief statement of present and future research plans, and three letters of recommendation, solicited by the applicant.
